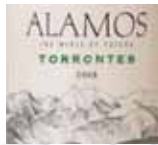


Aromatic Whites

Alamos Torrontés Argentina

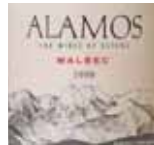
Torrontés has a unique expression in Argentina and has often been called the country's signature white varietal. The wine is light and fresh on the palate with excellent balance and finishing with bright, crisp acidity.



Starborough Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand

A plush, approachable style, highlighted by the refreshing fruit accents and bold acidity that characterize wines from this region. The wine shows flavors of honeydew melon, passion fruit, and peach over a citrus background.

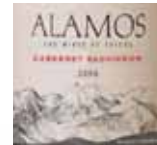
Alamos Malbec Argentina

The nose shows ripe black fruits, black pepper spice and floral notes. The mouthfeel is full yet soft and supple, with black raspberry and currant flavors mingled with notes of sweet spice and a touch of leather. The finish is long and persistent with soft, sweet tannins.



Alamos Malbec Selección Argentina

Full and rich with ripe black cherry and cassis fruit layered with notes of wildflowers, spicy black pepper and anis. Nice vivid purple and blue fruit flavors run through this red, with creamy-textured mocha, spice cake and licorice notes and a lively, fruit-filled finish.



Alamos Cabernet Sauvignon Argentina

Explosive, with red fruit flavors, sweet spice and a touch of fresh mint. The mouthfeel is full yet soft, with red currant and cassis fruit layered with notes of leather and ripe black fruits. The finish is focused, with finely grained tannins adding structure and length.
